



Code of Conduct

Welcome to the McBride & District Public Library. Everyone is welcome here.

Our mission is to be the heart of community connections. Our vision is a community where everyone enriches the world in their own way.

To that end, people using the library and people working at the library have the right to a space that is safe, welcoming, and invites learning and discovery.

While in the library:

- I am respectful of other people.
 - I consider noise-levels.
 - I am aware that some need a fragrance-free environment.
 - I leave my pets outside except for service or support animals. Animals may be invited in for special programs or services.
- I am respectful of sharing space.
 - I acknowledge and accept differences within our community.
 - I am aware that different sensibilities may also see what I am doing online.
 - I use the library with consideration of other people's safety and enjoyment.
- I respect the privacy of other library patrons and staff.
 - I give space for others to use library resources as they wish.
 - I will seek permission from staff to take photographs within the library building and grounds.
- I am respectful of property and library policies.
 - I refrain from smoking or vaping on library property or within 3 metres of any entrance.
 - I park my bike in the racks provided or away from exits and pathways.
 - I do not consume food or drink in the computer lab.
 - I do not consume alcohol or cannabis on library property.
- I am responsible for my family and my belongings. I tidy up after we use the space.
- I recognize employees' right to work free from any kind of harassment.

I understand that if I do not follow this Code, I may be asked to leave.
